



The Top-Selling Vehicles in America

Vehicle sales may have slowed due to the COVID-19 pandemic and a global chip shortage,

but Americans still bought plenty of trucks (and some cars).

The Ford F-Series dominates sales in the Midwest and is the top selling vehicle in 60% of the U.S.



48/50 states have a truck or SUV as the top selling vehicle in 2020.









American manufacturers Ford, Chevrolet, and Ram had the top-selling vehicles in 39/50 states.





















California and Florida were the only states with a car as the top selling vehicle in 2020.







Japanese manufacturers Toyota and Honda had the top-selling vehicles along the coastlines in 11 states and D.C.

















National Snapshot

- Trucks, specifically the Ford 150 are the highest selling vehicles in America
- In 2021, there were 787,422 F-Series trucks sold in America
- In 2020, the top three best selling vehicles were trucks
- Out of the top twenty best selling vehicles in 2021, six of them are pick-up trucks

Seatbelt Usage and Crash Data





 The data show that there is a higher probability of pick-up trucks being crashed in rural areas, despite passenger cars leading the number of crashes in non-rural areas

New Safety Features

- New trucks across the market are adopting safety features including forward collision warning, AEB, lane keep assist, and lane departure warning
- Some of the newer pick-up trucks, including the 2020 Honda Ridgeline, 2021 Ford F-150, 2021 Ram 1500, have received 5 out of 5 stars for safety according to NHTSA's safety rating system
