GO Teams are . . .


- Technical assistance to help Tribes address a specific, identified crash data need
- Assistance is provided by 1-3 subject matter experts
- Free to Tribes
- For Real and happening now! First GO Team was deployed to develop data sharing agreements

Other possible GO Team objectives:

- Problem ID and countermeasure development
- Developing a strategic plan and performance measures
- Data integration

Tribal Crash Data Reporting Toolkit

- Providing Tribes with a set of tools and guidance to help them make better use of their crash data
- The core of toolkit is the Crash Form and Crash Database



Other Tools in the Kit

- Three guidance documents:
 - Police Instruction Tool
 - Data Analysis Tool
 - Quality Control Tool
- Crash Data Facts & Fiction Tool
- Toolkit Manual: describing the other six tools

- August 7: Project kick off
- October 2: Initial draft of the Crash Data Facts & Fiction Tool is due &
 - Contractor will begin consulting with pilot Tribes

April 2020: Demonstration of electronic Crash Tool

June 2020: Demo of Database Tool

August 2020: Toolkit finalized, project closeout webinar
